
#### ⑤KHALIFAH MUJAHID JAMAL A (Saudi Arabia)





# International C Hour ~Bamboo dragonfly~

# [29 May (Thu) · General Research Building 6th floor, Meeting Room]

Mr. Furukawa, representative of the "Okhotsk bamboo dragonfly club", and other 5 members taught us how to make a bamboo dragonfly, a traditional Japanese toy. The participants looked uneasy because most of them had no experience of making it before, but they finished making their own bamboo dragonfly smoothly, receiving helpful advice

Some international students, who had difficulty in using the tools and twisting the bamboo wings, screamed with delight when their bamboo dragonfly flied in the air. We would like international students to spread the Japanese bamboo dragonfly that people of all ages can enjoy after going back to their country.







## How to make a bamboo dragonfly

We learned two ways to make a bamboo dragonfly. The first way is to scrape the center of the bamboo wings with a knife. The other way is to wrap the center of bamboo wings in an aluminum foil and twist the bamboo wings while holding them over the fire of a candle. Then insert the bamboo stick into the center of wings and solidify with an adhesive to finish!
